

The Pace Car Program is a citizen-based traffic calming initiative coordinated by the Community Services Bureau at the West Allis Police Department that promises to slow traffic and reduce car use.

The mission of this program is to make West Allis a safer place to walk, drive and bike within our neighborhoods and on the city streets.

## How does the Pace Car Program Work?


By joining the Pace Car Program, you voluntarily sign up and pledge to:

- Drive within the speed limit
- Stop for pedestrians
- Stop at all stop signs
- Stop at all red lights
- Drive courteously
- Reduce car usage & explore alternative methods of transportation
- Display a Pace Car Sticker on your vehicle

## CITIZENS SETTING THE PACE

Not only do Pace Car Participants set the example by adhering to the speed limit, they literally set the pace for other vehicles driving behind them.

Citizens who commit to the Pace Car Pledge agree to display the West Allis Pace Car Program sticker on the back window of their vehicle. This sticker is designed to alert other motorists to be mindful of the designated speed limit.
