Children 3 - 18 years

No cost. *Limited time only, while supplies last. See below if supplies run out.*

Children 6 mos - 18 years

No cost IF child:

- Has no health insurance
 - Has health insurance but vaccines are not covered
 - Has Medicaid (ForwardHealth)
 - Is American Indian or Native Alaska
- \$30.00 per dose (cash or check only)

Adults 19 - 64 years

Medicaid (ForwardHealth) **and** Medicare Part B accepted
\$30.00 (cash or check only)

Adults 65 years and older

Medicare Part B **and** Medicare Advantage Plans accepted
\$30.00 regular dose (cash or check only)
\$50.00 high dose (cash or check only)

Please bring all insurance cards including ForwardHealth, Medicare, and Medicare Advantage Plans
