

The West Allis Health Department offers a vast array of services. Listed below is a sample of some of the many services provided in 2017:

Vital Records

- 25,668 certificates processed –
 - 3,933 birth certificates
 - 21,735 death certificates

WIC

- 2,699 individuals served
- 18,673 food packages issued
- 75.3% of moms initially fed breast milk to their babies

Environmental Health

- 429 establishments licensed
- 1,000+ nuisance complaints received
- \$23,000 awarded for Food Inspection Program Project
- 100+ Temporary or Mobile Food Vendors inspected at City events
- 9 lead related investigations

West Allis Farmers Market

- 42 Vendors
- 10 Street Vendors
- 33 Vendors accepting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) tokens

Dental

- 1,697 fluoride varnish treatments applied

Healthy Homes Program

- 140 smoke and/or combined smoke/carbon monoxide alarms were installed benefiting 103 residents. (This was a combined effort of the West Allis Health Dept. and the West Allis Fire Dept. through a Community Development Block Grant.)
- 103 Healthy Homes buckets were distributed benefiting 358 residents
- 50 pillow and mattress covers given to those with asthma, benefiting 193 residents
- 15 Victory Gardens will be installed into yards of income eligible families in May 2018

Community Health Services

- 1,895 immunizations administered
- 1,266 flu shots administered
- 254 TB skin tests administered
- 894 communicable diseases reported & follow up completed
- 2,376 lead tests/screenings performed
- 71 elevated lead levels referrals for follow up
- 39 mother/baby referrals to Public Health Nursing
- 81 high risk pregnant referrals to Public Health Nursing
- 2,508 vision/hearing tests –
 - 330 children referred to their doctors
