This permit is issued under the authority of the Revised Municipal Code, Section 10.065, subject to all rules and requirements incorporated therein.

Loading Zone- A loading zone is defined as that portion of a public street adjacent to a curb or property line reserved for the exclusive use of vehicles loading or unloading passengers or material.

Special Parking Zone- A Special parking zone is defined as that portion of a public street adjacent to a curb or property line where parking is limited to thirty (30) minutes or less.

Applications for loading zones and special parking zones permits shall be made by the owner or lessee of the property abutting the zone areas, shall be made in writing on forms provided. Permits shall be issued after review and approval of the City Engineer. If the application for a permit is denied, an appeal from such decision may be made to the Board of Public Works, whose decision shall be final. All permits shall be in force for a period of one (1) year or less and shall expire on the 1st day of May, unless revoked by the Board of Public Works.

FEE SCHEDULE:

Initial Application. Three dollars (\$3) for each linear foot of loading or special parking zone in an unmetered area with a minimum fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75); and, four dollars (\$4) for each linear foot of loading or special parking zone in a metered area with a minimum fee of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120)

Annual Renewals. Two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) for each foot of loading or special parking zone in an unmetered area with a minimum of sixty (\$60); and, three dollars (\$3) for each linear foot of loading or special parking zone in a metered area with a minimum fee of ninety (\$90).

Fees schedules listed above are subject to periodic review and update by the Board of Public Works. Annual renewal of the permit may be affected upon the payment of designated fee.
