WE ARE STAYING SAFE

We're following guidelines to protect the safety of our workers and our customers, including:


RE-OPENING WEST ALLIS - As of May 22, the order issued by the Suburban Milwaukee Health Officers expired and all remaining businesses will be allowed to open. However, the threat of COVID-19 is still present in West Allis and West Milwaukee. West Allis and West Milwaukee currently **have a higher rate of positive cases** as it relates to total tests performed than the Wisconsin state average. Local public health leaders have tracked key indicators to guide the safe reopening across the city. Currently in **Phase B**, recommendations include retailers at no more than 50% occupancy or 8 people per 1,000 sq. feet, restaurants and salons at no more than 50% capacity while limiting gatherings to 10 or less people.

Are we out of the woods yet?

No. Even though social distancing orders have been lifted, there is still reason for Wisconsinites to take continued precautions.

On May 20, 2020, Wisconsin hit a 30-day high of **528 new positive COVID-19 cases**. And while it is true that more daily tests are being performed, the percentage of positive tests from all tests performed is also spiking (**8% positive** on 5/20/20).
