WIS 100 I-43 TO HANK AARON STATE TRAIL



September 18, 2020

As part of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) WIS 100 (I-43 to Hank Aaron State Trail) resurfacing project, the upcoming overnight closures are scheduled for the next phase of the project.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Beginning Wednesday, September 23, 2020:

- WIS 100, from just south of Lapham Street to Hank Aaron State Trail, is scheduled to fully close to traffic overnight from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night for approximately one week, while crews perform paving operations.

The following intersections will be fully closed to through traffic in all directions on WIS 100 during the overnight full closure:

- Lapham, Orchard, Madison, B, Washington, and Walker streets
- Greenfield Avenue
- Theodore Trecker Way

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

Alternate Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to use I-894, I-94, National, and Lincoln avenues to get around the closure.

Businesses and residents should be aware that noise and dust is associated with this work and that steps will be taken to minimize these impacts.
