The Alternate Care Facility at Wisconsin State Fair Park was activated on October 14, 2020. The facility will serve as an overflow facility for hospitals to support COVID-19 patients who are not severely ill but still require continued medical support.

As of October 27th, 2020, **7.6% of West Allis & West Milwaukee COVID-19 cases were ever hospitalized.** This is slightly above the State average of 5.2%.

Milwaukee County hospitals are currently below capacity and as of 10/27/20 report 14.4% of Milwaukee County hospital beds in use for COVID-19 positive patients.

Traditional Halloween activities are fun, but some can increase the risk of getting or spreading COVID-19 or influenza.

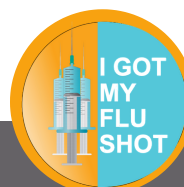
Make trick-or-treating safer with these CDC suggestions:
