COVID TIMELINE: FROM SYMPTOMS TO CONTACTS

WATCH FOR SYMPTOMS



Do you have?

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion/runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea



GET TESTED

Get tested if you have symptoms or were contacted by a COVID-19 positive person

QUARANTINE



**Stay home
and
quarantine
until you get
your test
results back**

NOTIFY CONTACTS



Inform anyone you had close contact with during your contagious period to quarantine at home for 14 days since they saw you last.

**When is a positive
'contagious'?**
Two days before
symptom onset and 10
days after.

ASYMPTOMATIC POSITIVE



**Did you test
positive but have
no symptoms? You
are still contagious!**
Isolate for 10 days
from the day you
were tested.

POSITIVE TEST RESULTS

Isolate for 10 days from symptom onset and monitor symptoms.

Resume normal activities only if:

- 10 day isolation is complete
- You are fever free for at least 24 hours, without medication
- You have improvement of other symptoms
