


WHEN APPROXIMATELY THREE INCHES OF SNOW FALLS IN A STORM, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS USUALLY PLOWS ALL CITY STREETS AND ALLEYS.


A Snow Emergency is declared through a radio or television announcement when a full scale plowing operation is initiated. Once declared, all parking is prohibited on major emergency thoroughfares only for the duration of the emergency. For residential parking, normal alternate side parking would be allowed during declared snow emergencies.

Past practice of staying on the same side of the street for the duration of a declared Snow Emergency has been eliminated. Regular residential parking restrictions would apply for all overnight parking. Snow Emergency regulations shall supersede all other overnight parking regulations for the duration of the Snow Emergency.

Finally, on certain streets other than emergency thoroughfares where one side of the entire block is permanently posted NO PARKING AT ANY TIME year-round, parking WILL be allowed on the opposite side during the declared Snow Emergency regardless of the calendar date on which the emergency is declared.

SNOW EMERGENCY THOROUGHFARES

There is no parking on the following streets during a snow emergency:

S. 60 St. from North City Limits to South City Limits

S. 66 St. from W. National Ave. to W. Burnham St.

S. 67 Pl. from W. Rogers St. to W. Beloit Rd.

S. 68 St. from W. National Ave. to South City Limits (South of W. Arthur Ave.)

S. 69 St. from W. Becher St. to W. Lincoln Ave.

S. 70 St. from North City Limits to W. Mitchell St.

S. 76 St. from North City Limits (North of W. Pierce St.) to W. Oklahoma Ave.

S. 81 St. from W. Greenfield Ave. to W. National Ave.

S. 84 St. from W. Schlinger Ave. to W. Oklahoma Ave.

S. 88 St. from W. Lincoln Ave. to 500 ft. south of W. Lincoln Ave.

S. 90 St. & W. Hayes Ave. from W. Lincoln Ave. to S. 92 St., including Hospital Emergency Intersection

S. 92 St. from North City Limits to W. Oklahoma Ave.

S. 100 St. from W. Schlinger Ave. to W. Madison Pl.

S. 101 St. from W. Madison Pl. to W. Greenfield Ave.

S. 108 St. from North City Limits to W. Morgan Ave.

S. 113 St. from W. Greenfield Ave. to W. Lapham St.

S. 116 St. from S. Curtis Rd. to W. Lincoln Ave.

S. 124 St. from North City Limits to W. Morgan Ave.

W. Becher St. from S. 67 Pl. to dead end of S. 99 St.

W. Beloit Rd. from East City Limits to W. Oklahoma Ave.

W. Burnham St. from East City Limits to S. 66 St.

W. Cleveland Ave. from S. 84 St. to S. 124 St.

S. Curtis Rd. from S. 116 St. to North City Limits (W. Fairview Ave.)

HOW TO PARK - MAJOR SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING REGULATIONS

During a MAJOR snow emergency, here's what changes from normal parking rules:

- No parking on either side of main thoroughfares. This keeps important roads clear for emergency vehicles, buses, and others.
- On all other streets:
 - Park on the even side of the street from midnight to 3 p.m. if the previous day was an even-numbered date.
 - Park on the odd side of the street from midnight to 3 p.m. if the previous day was an odd-numbered date.
 - Park on either side of the street from 3 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.



Winter Parking Regulations Effective Dec. 1 - March 31

Even Side of the Street	Odd Side of the Street	Either Side of the Street
From midnight to 3 p.m. if the previous day was an even-numbered date	From midnight to 3 p.m. if the previous day was an odd-numbered date	From 3 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. every day

▶ Nighttime parking permits are still required.

▶ When the City declares a major snow emergency, in addition to winter parking rules for side streets, there is no street parking on the main streets until the major snow emergency is over.
