



City of West Allis Bike Rack Program



Price

West Allis bike racks are available for purchase and installation by commercial property owners throughout the city for \$200, plus a \$75 installation fee when installed within the City right-of-way.

Placement

The bike racks are designed to allow riders to park bikes parallel to the rack, and generally allow for two bikes at a time. "West Allis" should be legible from the public frontage (see examples above).

Bike racks placed within city right-of-way (i.e. sidewalks) should note the following:

- Location within right-of-way is subject to approval of the City, based on space availability.
- Racks shall be placed 24 inches from the face of the curb, with at least 5 feet of clearance behind the rack for pedestrian passage.
- Racks shall be located with 3 feet of clearance on either side, avoiding infrastructure such as trees, fire hydrants and driveways.
- Racks shall be located in areas where riders may safely get on and off their bikes away from traffic and pedestrians.
- Racks will be privately owned, but installed on public property, with a waiver of a grant of privilege, to be provided by the Director of Engineering and Public Works.

Bike racks placed on private property should generally follow the same standards above, but installation shall be provided by the owner and a grant of privilege shall not be required.
